I looked at the sketches that I produced on paper and decided to work with the ones that I thought were the best and most interesting out of all of them and the four above are the result. I used Ariel for the font choice and then from that I changed the font appearance with effects on adobe illustrator. I tried to describe best what the words mean and for the majority of the part it turned out pretty nice.

My first choice was the word love made into the heart shape because that was most appealing and I like how that came out. I used the round corners effect to make the edges smooth and I also used an Italic $L$ to get a good angle for the bottom point. I did have to do some stretching to get the other letters to fit right but it definitely turned out to be my favorite. I think my second favorite was the flip because it appears that the letters are a statue with a shadow that says the actual word. I thought it was a good effect with the shadow below it.

My third choice would be the word trap with the trapped door between the letters of the $t$ and $p$. I wanted to make it look like the middle letters were stuck in a room from a trap door they fell through I do like how the fourth drawing came out but I think it is a little too simple for this project but it did turn out a little fun.

This was a fun project to digitalize the sketches because of the effects that we could use to portray the meaning of the words. I prefer to use digital software to create because I dont have to worry about getting ink all over myself and everything around me. It is also easier to go back and redo things.

Process-
I decided to switch from my best decision of the Love symbol to the trap because the love symbol seemed to be used a lot and my trap design was a little more unique. I decided to go with the thoughts of what our professor said would be best and designed it simply around what she described would be good. I also thought that those things that she pointed out worked well for the design.

Things that I like
I really like how the trapped door hanging off of the P makes it show that it's more like being trapped and kind of makes it fun. From the original design that I did to this new design things turned out a little better. The letters arent distorted and the kerning is brought closer together. I worked with the letters to make them close enough that the middle area looks like a room where the R and A are stuck in. I also made the letters a little smaller than half the letter size from the outsided letters so they look inferior. Originally I had the letters in the middle look like they were laying down at the bottom but that took away from the concept of keeping the proportions of the letters.

Things I would do over
If I could redo the assignment I would probably do a different font and play around with different sizing of the fonts. I would also move the letters around so that they would maybe show action where one of the middle letters would be falling down the trapped door extending from the $P$.
